


## **GREEKLIFEEDU Student Directions: New Members**

Dear Student,

As you may know, The University of Minnesota has partnered with [EverFi](#), whose mission is to help students address critical life skills such as alcohol abuse prevention, financial literacy, digital citizenship, etc. in high schools and higher education institutions across the country. Each year students across the country complete GreekLifeEdu - their online, non-opinionated, science-based alcohol abuse prevention course for students involved in Greek organizations.

As part of our comprehensive alcohol prevention program, IFC and PHC will expect each new member to complete this course. Whether you drink or not, GreekLifeEdu will empower you to make well-informed decisions about alcohol and help you better cope with the drinking behavior of your peers.

The course has two sections, **both** of which must be **completed to fulfill this requirement**:



- Part 1 of the course takes approximately 1.5-2.5 hours to complete and we recommend that you take it in multiple sittings. This part ends after Survey 2 and the Exam. You must earn a grade of 85% or higher to pass and receive credit for the course. **The deadline for finishing Part 1 is November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013.**
- About **one month** after you complete Part 1, you will receive an email asking you to complete Part 2. **The deadline to complete Part 2 is December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2013.**

Please note that the course includes three surveys that help personalize your experience and measure students' alcohol-related attitudes and behaviors. All survey responses are strictly confidential; the organization will only receive information about the organization as whole and will never see individual students' answers.

**IFC and PHC have instituted fines to chapters with any member not completing part 1 by the deadline of \$15/person. Failure to complete part 1 and 2 by the December 20<sup>th</sup> deadline will result in chapters being suspended from **Spring Jam** participation.**

To begin AlcoholEdu for College:

1. Go to: [www.greeklifeedu.com](http://www.greeklifeedu.com)
2. Under New User, enter the following Login ID: 13GUMTC
3. Click "Sign Up"
4. On the registration page, you will have the opportunity to create your GreekLifeEdu account using your email address and a password of your choice. Once you have created your account, you will be ready to get started in the course.
5. You may log in and out of the course at the end of each module.
6. When you return, log in as a Returning User and enter the same email address and password you created when you first logged into the course.

Should you experience any difficulties or require support, the AlcoholEdu Online Technical Support Center is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Simply click on the "Technical Help" button located in the upper right-hand corner of every AlcoholEdu for College screen. You do not need to be logged into the course to access the Technical Support Center.
